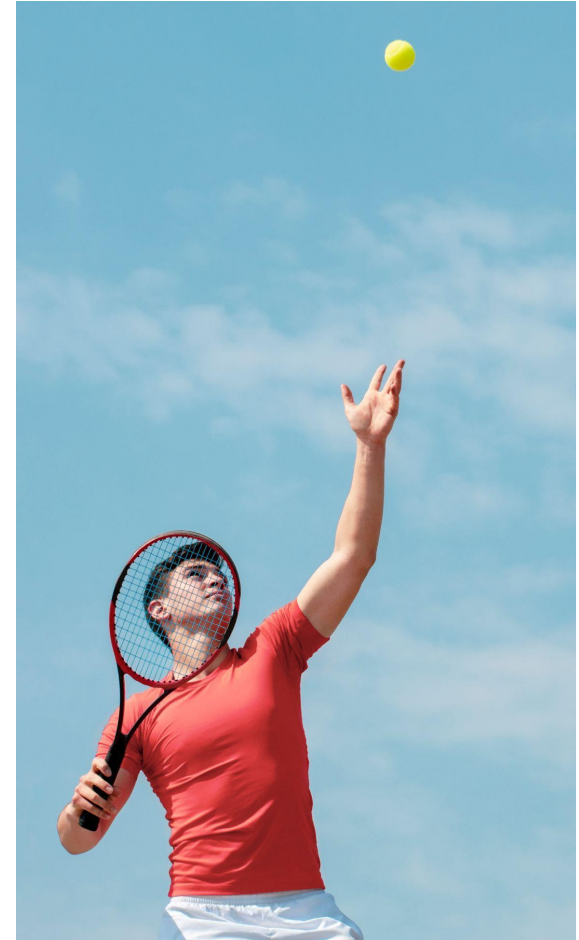


Fun Fact
