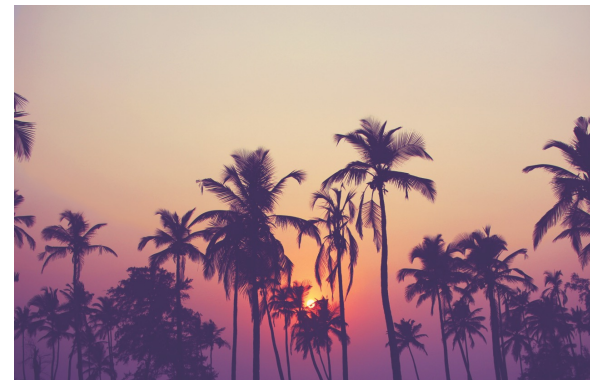

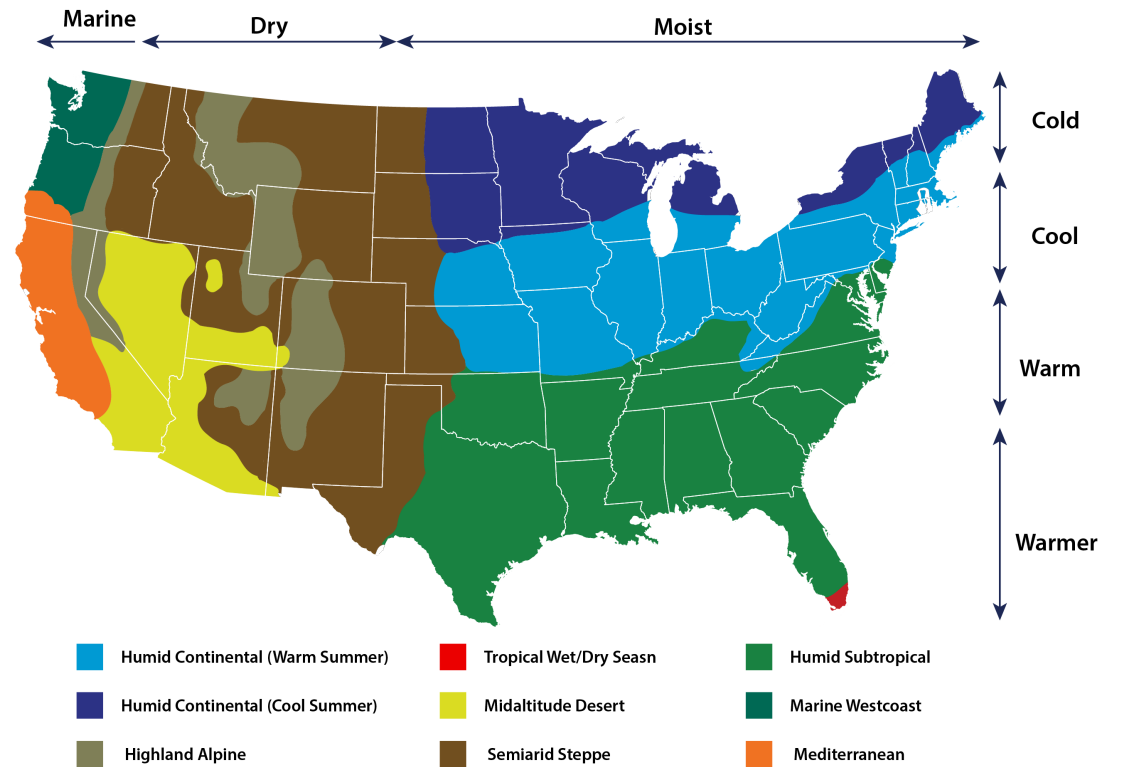
Based on review of weather patterns, what is the best climate for outdoor activities and golf?
